Farming is the oldest industry in the state. It's proud heritage traces roots well before the first colonist settled in New Jersey. Many orchards date to colonial times, and the farms have been passed down to each generation. New Jersey produces over 30 different varieties of apples.

Winesap, originated in New Jersey in the late 1700's, and the Northern Spy have been enjoyed for years. Others, such as Granny Smith, Fuji, Jonagold, Gala, and Mutsu are fairly new. Regardless of your tastes, you are sure to be satisfied by the many varieties grown in New Jersey orchards.

Here are some Tips...

- **Keep Cool.**

Apples continue to ripen after being picked. Storing in a cool environment retards the process. Never store apples at room temperature; it will ruin their flavor.

- **Buy in Season.**

Despite refrigeration, like all fruits, apples have an optimum season when flavor, freshness, and its nutritional value peak.

- **Buy Local.**

Even under the best conditions, shipping and storage can have adverse effects on fruit quality. Buying local is the best way to be sure you are getting the most nutritious food. Plus supporting local growers helps preserve family farms.

CARMEL APPLE WALNUT PIE

8 Tblsp butter
3 Tblsp lemon juice
3/4 cup sugar
1/2 tsp ground cinnamon
6 cups apples, thinly sliced (tart and firm)
2 Tblsp cornstarch
2 tsp vanilla extract
13 soft caramel candies
1 unbaked pie crust (homemade or 9" frozen)
3/4 cup chopped walnuts
1/4 cup flour
1/3 cup brown sugar

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Melt 4 table-
spoons of butter (saving remainder for later
use). Add lemon juice, sugar and cinnamon.
Add the apples and cook until slightly soft.
Remove from heat and let cool. Stir in corn
starch, vanilla and caramels. (add heat as need-
ed to melt candies) Place crust into 9" pie pan
(or use 9" frozen). Mound the apple caramel
mixture into the crust. Melt remaining butter.
Mix in flour, brown sugar and walnuts. Top pie
with this walnut mixture and bake for 50-60
minutes at 350 until golden brown. Allow to
cool for at least one hour before slicing.
